Martin Luther King Jr (MLK) was born January 15th, 1929 in Atlanta (Georgia). He was a church leader and fought against racial segregation in the USA in the 1950s – 1960s. He was a civil rights activist. In 1953, he married Coretta Scott. They had four children. In 1963, he gave a famous speech "I have a dream". MLK was assassinated on April 4th, 1968 in Memphis, Tennessee.

Last week, the pupils from the « Villanelles » school ran to win tokens to use on the various stands in the village hall. Cash donations will help people who suffer from genetic diseases.

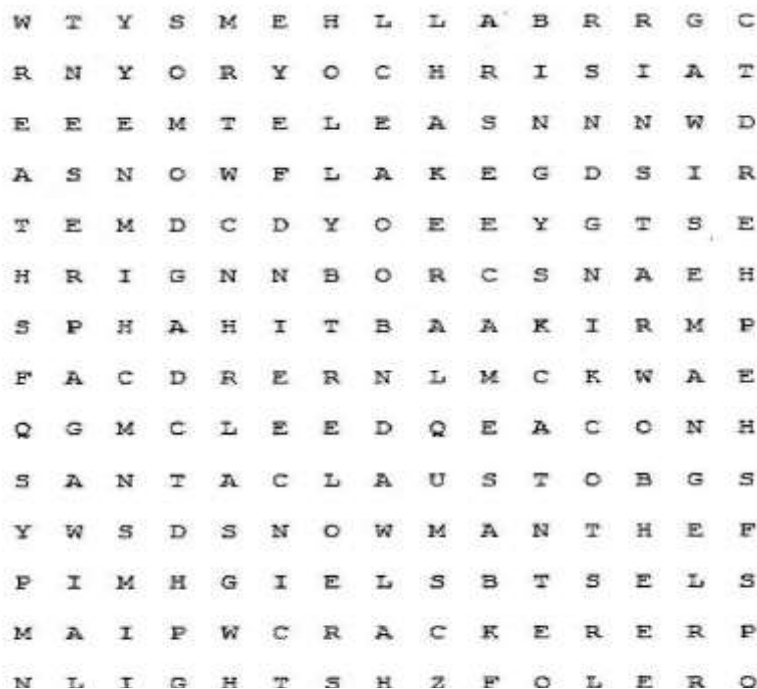
To win tokens, pupils from the primary school made drawings to decorate the walls of the village hall.

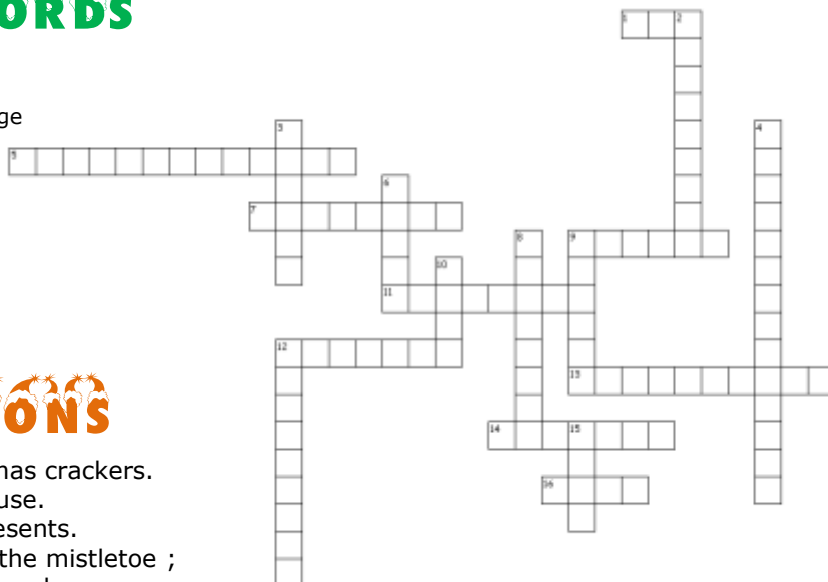
